In the past season we again had our fair share of challenges to overcome, but I am happy to report, again, that our team got on with the job and did what needed to be done and got the jobs done.

in Hervey Bay is in a very strong position heading into the future with growing patrol numbers and more interest from people wanting to join our club.

Highlights include our Patrol Teams and Age Managers already meeting to discuss next season's program.

Also, we had nine (9) members undertake training with the RWC program - this is a significant achievement. I sincerely thank those who have committed to this extra duty.

As many are now aware, the demands of a volunteer organisation are significant, and it is a team effort to ensure we can take to the beach weekly.

Again, I sincerely thank those who turned up and contributed to ensure our season was a success. There are too many to name individually, but I can assure you I am extremely grateful for your support and dedication to our club and the safety of our beachgoing community.

To our members who put up their hand to volunteer next season, thank you in advance for your support. Next season will see more changes introduced with our Parental Participation Program. This adjustment to the program will allow the continued delivery of our Nipper program. We understand this change will not suit everybody, but our program is about your children, and we need you to partner with us in the important investment in your children's future.

This season we again supplied nine (9) patrols every weekend and on public holidays from September to May. With our volunteers investing 3,493.31 hours into our beach. We have again delivered on Surf Life Saving Queensland's primary objective of Zero Preventable Deaths in Queensland public waterways. I thank everybody who has patrolled and carried out water safety duties with the Hervey Bay Surf Life Saving Club this season.

Next season we are committed to working to ensure our members can develop their skill on other beaches where and when possible. We are also going to focus on the attraction and retention of patrolling members, to grow our active patrolling numbers while balancing the demands of the modern world.

I sincerely thank our committee for their combined commitments this season. The effort required to deliver our programs and the hours spent by a small and dedicated group involved with the best Surf Life Saving Club in Hervey Bay is massive, and I thank everybody who have taken the time to get involved with us. I will thank in advance those that put their hand up and get involved in 2022/23.

Well, a great year behind us, coming out of COVID and we are in a good position going forward.

I received a call from Surf Life Saving Queensland in August, informing me that a bequest had been made to the club, a couple of thousand dollars thought! Well, to be told that this anonymous donor had in fact left us \$320,000.00, had no next of kin and as far as we can ascertain had nothing to do with Surf Lifesaving, a most generous donation.... I was a little lost for words!! Investigations ensued and I found out the benefactor lived in Maryborough and indeed had no link to the club or surf lifesaving. We have since found out that there were five (5) other community groups who were bequeathed similar amounts of monies. Thank You to this Donor, this has set the club up financially for the foreseeable future.

Again, we have been fortunate to secure a substantial amount of grant monies this year, my thanks go to the SLSQ Grant Writing Unit for their assistance in wording our grant applications to maximise our chances of gaining funding. This year we have been fortunate in obtaining over \$60,000.00 in grant monies being acquitted against: \$15,000.00 for the replacement of two of our IRB Motors, \$5,000.00 grant from the Fraser Coast Regional Council towards a new Racing Mal, \$12,000.00 from the casino grant to purchase new boards and skis for our master's contingent, \$30,000.00 from SLSQ, QFES and SLSA for VMR grants and More Beaches Under Guard to replace our Patrol equipment. Grants seem to be "drying up" a little now COVID is a part of our lives. I will continue to apply for grants as they become available but equipment wise, we are in a good position with our big-ticket items all fairly new.

Without the financial support from our sponsors and the countless hours of assistance from our volunteers, we could not function as successfully as we do. They believe in what we do as a club and their support is invaluable. We would also like to acknowledge the Hervey Bay Surf Life Saving Supporters Club for their ongoing financial assistance of the Hervey Bay Surf Life Saving Club. The Supporters Club had a reasonable year and has donated over \$10,000.00 to the Surf Club this season. My thanks to the Supporters Club Committee and Volunteers who have manned the bar this season, this being where a high volume of the Supporters Club income is generated, from which this enables them to donate to the Hervey Bay Surf Life Saving Club.

#### PATROLS

After a bumpy start to the season, with a few hiccups with the Patrol Roster, the Club Captain stepping away, Ron and I stepping into the Acting Club Captain role and two (2) patrols with basically no members, we made it. I believe the 2021-2022 was a massive turning point from a Patrol perspective. I know we still have work to do, but all in all it was a very successful season. Everyone should hold their heads high and be proud of their achievements for the year.

I'd like to personally thank all the active patrolling members that volunteered their time to patrol our wonderful beach throughout the Season and welcome our 13 new Bronze and 15 SRC members to Hervey Bay Surf Life Saving Club.

The volunteers that patrol the Beach are the 'Heart and Soul' of every Surf Club. Without active patrolling members, we would not be able to run a Nipper program, there'd be no Surf Sports Competition and basically no Surf Club. The total volunteer hours by our active members for the season were a staggering 3493 hours.

We made a few changes this season from previous seasons, and I believe they were for the better. We moved to half day patrols on public holidays from three (3) hrs, meaning less public holiday patrols for members. Along with changing Christmas Day to a volunteer Patrol, which I must give a massive thank you to the 17 members that gave up part of their Christmas Day to patrol our beach, you are all Legends. I have had some great feedback with a fantastic day had by all. I am looking forward to seeing even more of you there this year with your Surf Club family.

Although it was a relatively quiet season with rescues and serious incidents, one emergency situation that must get a special mention was early in the season, when Patrol 4 was called to a man with chest pains on a catamaran out from the Sailing Club. Three (3) of our members; PC Jason Parnell, Helen Thomas and Ron Thomas attended to the casualty, while the remainder of the patrol team maintained a vigil on the swimmers in the flagged area. It was discovered that the casualty had a heart attack. The outstanding, professional, fast acting actions of our patrol members to respond and care for the casualty until the ambulance took over need to be commended. Well done team.

This incident goes to show how quickly things can go wrong in and around the water, even in a town like Hervey Bay with our treacherous seas. Hervey Bay Surf Life Saving Club has an important role to play in community safety and engagement.

This year we have had many members go above and beyond. These members all put in over 60 hours over the season between the Red and Yellow Flags on Patrol.

The year started well with pool swims and sign on going well.

Our first carnival for the start of the season was our Hervey Bay Masters Carnival on the 11<sup>th of</sup> September 2021. This is the first carnival of the year for Masters to attend. This year we had good numbers again, roughly 100 entries with 10 of those being from our club. The Masters Carnival is predominately attended by clubs from the Sunny Coast who like to come and have fun and compete in a very laid-back carnival that eases everyone back into the new season.

We had a lot of good results across the carnival, finishing with 12 first placings, 10 second placings and 12 third placings (results of all this season's carnivals including competitors names and places are later in the book). A very good result overall with only 10 competitors competing with a couple of them having their first taste of Surf Life Saving Carnivals

The next carnival on the list was North Aussies, for Under 11 to Masters, which is held at Mackay each year in late October. This is a long drive but well worth it for our competitors, especially our Under 13 to Under 17 competitors who have a chance of making the Queensland Country Team, which is a team chosen only from this carnival. The team has six (6) males and females for each of the age groups; four (4) water competitors and two (2) beachies. This year our Nippers did fantastic with three (3) being chosen in the team; Millie Jackson, Grace Wright and Emmily Lingard, with another two (2) being chosen as reserves; Ariana Rasmussen and Tallen Gunn. Not to be out-done, Kym Lingard won Age Champion for her age group at the carnival.

In total we had 23 competitors compete at North Aussies, returning with a bag full of medals; 10 Gold ,19 Silver and 17 Bronze overall.

A special thanks must also go out to all the officials and water safety.

Our 4-point Carnivals were well attended this year again and it is great to see so many new faces getting involved and cheering our little Nippers on. As the results from our 4-Point Carnivals are so big, I have not recorded in this section of the book as they will be shown later in the book. All I can say is a fantastic effort and results by everyone and it is so good to see so many smiling kids competing and having fun.

For the Seniors Under 15 to Masters, next came the Premiership Series. Both Round 1 and Round 2 were down on competitors with our club having 10 competitors at the first carnival and nine (9) at the second carnival. Although numbers were down our guys had a great time competing in the Surf at Agnes Waters. The group returned with a staggering 55 Gold, 30 Silver and 5 Bronze placings over the two (2) carnivals.

Junior and Senior Branch were the two (2) next carnivals for the club.

The Senior Branch Championships were held first at Emu Park and like normal we had good numbers, a total of 21 competitors pulled on the red and white cap to proudly represent our club. We had quite a few competitors competing for the first time, which is always good to see.

Although our numbers were not the biggest at the carnival, we defiantly made the other clubs sit up and take notice. We returned with a massive 25 Gold, 16 Silver and 23 Bronze plus a lot of 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> placings. All in all, it was a great carnival.

Then came Junior Branch held at Bundy.

We had 42 competitors attend and that put a lot of pressure on the club to supply Officials (remember we need to supply one (1) Official for every eight (8) or part of competitors, therefore we needed six (6) Officials). This was looking grim to start with until we were able to get some Officials to put their hands up after asking and explaining to them the outcome if we didn't have the Officials. So, for this carnival especially, I would like to thank the Officials; Carolyn, Big Kev, Craig, John and myself, with a special mention to Vicky Perry who drove up Saturday morning to

officiate while her daughter Zara did water safety. As Zara is Under 15, both of them had no reason to be there to help the club out but thankfully they did, otherwise eight (8) of our young Nippers would not have been able to compete.

Now onto the good stuff. Those young Nippers had a fantastic carnival with so many smiling faces regardless of where they finished in their race. Results were good as well, returning with 27 Gold, 17 Silver and 21 Bronze Medals.

On Saturday night at our team get together, the kids were running around having fun and wearing their medals proudly. This is a great time for the club to grow and meet each other, especially the Officials, as they do not get to see a lot during the day. It's always something I look forward to, something as simple as just being able to sit back have a few drinks and listen to all the Nippers' achievements plus meeting some of the new parents.

Besides these carnivals we also had Branch Surf Rescue and State Surf Rescue at Bundy.

We had two (2) young ladies, Zara and Hannah, compete in the Under 15 Champion Lifesaver Event and then they teamed up and did the Under 15 First Aid Competition. For both, it was their first time competing at this event. This is a big carnival because it involves everything to do with Surf Life Saving from water and beach events to multiple choice questions plus CPR and live patient assessments.

Zara then attended the State Championships where she gained a lot of experience and knowledge from other competitors, which she will be able to use next year.

Well done to both the girls for stepping out of your comfort zones and giving this awesome event a go.

The final carnival attended by our mighty red and white team was Aussies, where we had three (3) competitors compete against the best in the country and although we are only a little club, the guys returned with three (3) top six (6) placings.

Kym Lingard finished 4<sup>th</sup> in her age group for the Female Surf Race and 6<sup>th</sup> for the Female 2km Ocean Swim, Jeff Luke returned with a 4<sup>th</sup> in his age group for Ironman,

The 3<sup>rd</sup> competitor was Guy Paxton, who might not have returned with any placings but had a great time and represented our club proudly.

That's it for carnivals this year, due to the floods Youth and Senior State Championships were cancelled.

Finishing off, I would like to thank everyone who helped at carnivals this year, they are long days and the more hands we can get helping the easier it is for everyone. I would also like to thank all the parents for allowing their children to be a part of this amazing movement. Thanks to all the patrolling members and committee members for keeping our club moving in the right direction. Special thanks to Wayne and the Junior Committee for another fantastic season. Final thanks go to our three (3) new officials, Brendon Jackson plus Chris and Renae O'Brien.
